

CLINTON COMMUNITY THEATRE QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Q. When is the show?

A. *Oklahoma!* is Friday and Saturday July 17, 18, 24 & 25 @ 7:30 pm.

Q. If I can't make the tech week rehearsals or one of the performances, can I still do the show?

A. In respect to all the other cast members, no you cannot do the show.

Q. Who is the production staff for *Oklahoma!*?

Q. Will everyone be cast that auditions?

A. Unfortunately, no. We will have to keep the size of the cast to a manageable amount due to costuming and space on stage. The cast will be posted on our website—www.clintoncommtheatre.com

Q. How big of a cast are you looking for?

A. We are looking for a cast of approximately 35.

Q. If I don't get the part I am auditioning for, can I still be part of the cast?

A. Yes. The production staff casts the show with who they feel is best for a particular role/character; including the ensemble.

Q. Is there a fee to participate in this production?

A. Yes, due to the costs associated *Oklahoma!*, we are asking for a \$30 per family registration fee payable to CLINTON COMMUNITY THEATRE by Sunday, June 28th.

We also ask for a refundable \$25 script deposit; returned following set strike and return of the script to us.

If this is a hardship, please see Rob or Julie as soon as possible so arrangements can be made.

Q. When do we start rehearsals?

A. We start rehearsals on Sunday June 7th at 2:00 pm. It is a read-thru with all speaking roles.

Q. What is the rehearsal schedule?

A. SUNDAYS:

2pm – 5:30pm

TUESDAYS:

7pm – 9:30pm

THURSDAYS:

7pm – 9:30pm

These will be music, dance and/or blocking. A specific schedule will be given detailing dates and rehearsal information.

Q. If cast, do I have to go to every rehearsal?

A. No. You only need to go to the rehearsals that are for your character / role. In other words, if you are not in a particular scene, dance or song being worked on, you most likely do not have to be there.

Q. What happens if I am sick or cannot make a rehearsal?

A. You should email Bill (BeachguyNL@aol.com) or Rob (RWN68@yahoo.com) as soon as possible.

Q. When is the set strike and do we have to attend?

A. All cast members are asked to be involved in some aspect of production work including set building, painting, costumes, etc. You are also required to attend the set strike on Sunday, July 27th at 2pm. After which, you will be given your \$25 deposit back. We also provide pizza at the completion of the strike. For those who do not do set strike or return a script; pizza is on you! We keep the deposit check.
